1) **Apologies**

2) **Minutes of previous meeting**

3) **Matters arising**

- a) A further project by the artist K Munro is being proposed and evaluated. The initial project is progressing well with good support from the school. The second project will be focused on the Forth and it may be possible to link this to the Gala.
- b) Turning Circle – A meeting has been held with Transportation Service. It appears a solution may be reached.
- c) Harbour Working Group – meeting held, further developments involving the village may occur.
- d) Scottish Water (Helen Lane) – meeting was held, further actions awaited, copy of correspondence to be sent to Helen Eadie MSP. **ACTION A Neville**
- e) Conservation Area – planner is absent from work at present. Ongoing
- f) Port Laing Parking – Letter received from Transportation advising that Environmental Services should be contacted regarding bins. Funding may be available from local charities. **ACTION J Hawkins**
- g) Beach clean-up – 12 & 13 of April
- h) Ferry Toll road markings – response awaited

4) **Fife Councillor's Business**

- a) Liaison Meetings (Cruiks Quarry and Deep Sea World) – not yet arranged by Fife Council, unlikely to be progressed until after the elections.
- b) Parking at Community Centre – Ongoing
- c) Roads/Pavement repairs – Ongoing
- d) Rail Bridge works – meeting held to discuss use of car park now planning permission has been granted. Problems with access to the viewing area were discussed. Further meeting to be held on 24 April at 10am.

25 calls from the village. Two cars had been broken into. Parking complaints on Main Street will be monitored. Speed guns will be used at problem locations in the village. DVLA initiative ongoing targeting untaxed vehicles, which will be removed. Transport Police informed about vandalism at the station. Under-age drinking being targeted.
