

Cruicks Quarry:

BA summarised the current situation regarding letters submitted for and against the application.

Planning:

A report had been received that, following construction of a new house at the eastern end of Post Office lane, part of the old public routeway appeared to be in the process of being grassed over and thus made to look as though it was private land. PD to approach the owner, with the Community Council's support.

Village Road Signs:

It was agreed that "WELCOME TO HISTORIC NORTH QUEENSFERRY" would be a suitable form of words for the new road signs featuring the Coat of Arms; subject to approval by FC Transportation Department.

Floral Enhancements:

Treasurers Report:
